## How can an immigrant association require the representativeness request?

#### Combine cumulatively the following requirements:

(Law ner 115/1999 of 3 Aug, approved by the Decree-Law ner 75/2000 of 9 May)

- Published statutes;
- Governing bodies regularly elected;
- Be registered on the National Register of Corporations;
- Have as their specific objectives the promotion of the rights and interests of immigrants or their descendants;
- Undertake activities to promote their rights and interests;
- Have a minimum of 100 members;
- At least 2 years of formal existence (COCAI's recommendation).

# How can an immigrant association require the representativeness request?

#### **Submit the following documents:**

- Copy of the statutes and their statement published at the Government Official Journal;
- Copy of the minutes of the governing bodies's election;
- Copy of the ID card of legal corporation;
- Association's history report;
- Activity and accounts report of the last financial year and annual working plan activities;
- Statement with the total number of members.

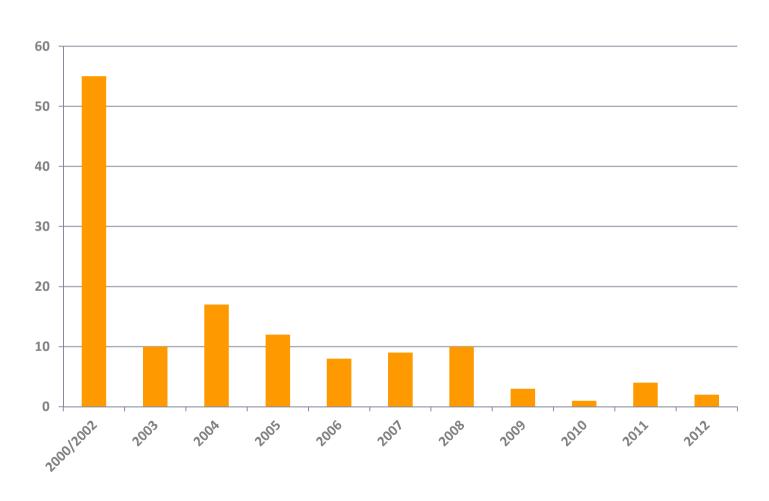
#### **Recognition Process**

- Applying for recognition and all the necessary documentation
- Application's analysis
- Support and monitoring
- Reconnaissence's visit
- Technical Report by GATAI
- Inform COCAI about the Technical Report
- Notify the associations about the final decision

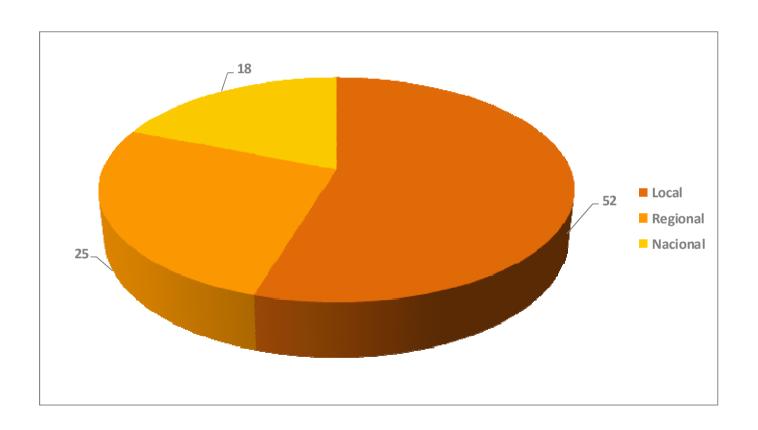

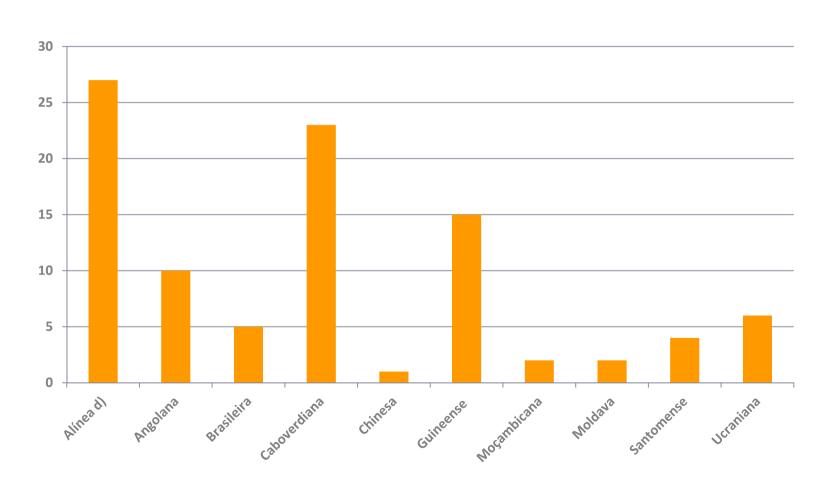
Number of recognised associations per year



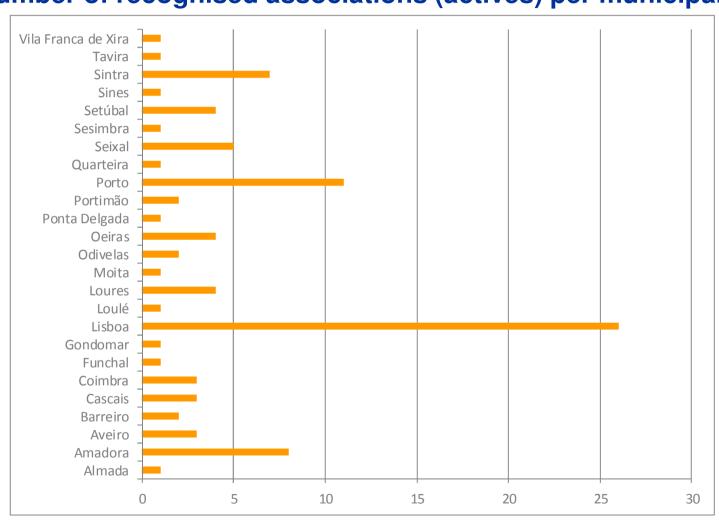
Number of recognised associations (actives) per range

#### **Technical Support**

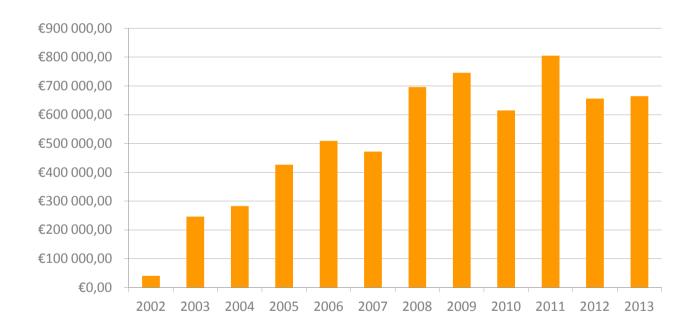
- Dissemination of the initiatives taken by immigrant associations

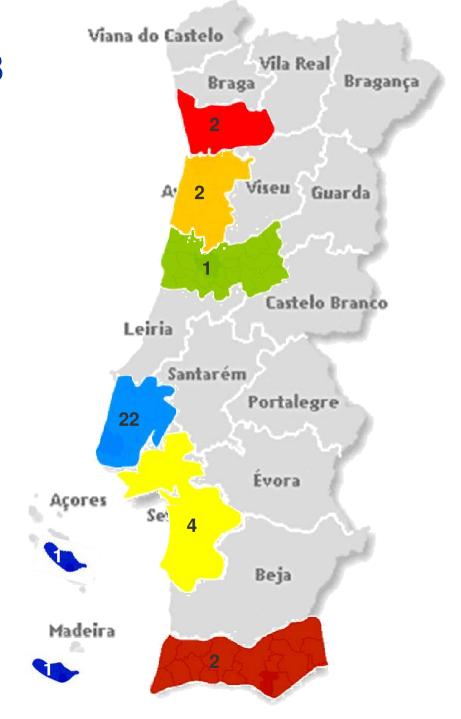
